Part A: Strategy Plan

Statement of Intent

- Sicrhau bod disgyblion ADY y gwneud cynnydd effeithiol.

We are committed to ensuring that every member of our family receives the best education in a homely and safe environment. Every member of the family is encouraged to reach their full potential whatever their ability through providing challenging and extended opportunities in order that he or she can become an independent learner in a bilingual society. Our aim is to nurture self-discipline, commitment, respect and pride in our language and our inheritance.

We believe that the most effective way to make use of the PDG Grant is to support e-fsm pupils and their families, by providing target support based around our pupil centred school improvement targets. Here we will target pupils who require particular approaches to support their engagement in learning. They are;

- *To develop pupils' literacy Skills*
- *To develop pupils' social Skills*
- *To ensure that pupils with ALN make effective progress.*
